 Requirements - Elementary Students who wish to qualify as SUMMIT READERS must read at least 500 minutes between now and April 30th. The signed reading chart and a signed copy of this sheet must be turned in to the teacher for each student by May 8.



- 2. **Rewards** Each student who reads the required number of minutes will receive one (1) free child day pass; valid at Splash Summit Waterpark in Provo. In consideration of those students who purchase(d) a Splash Summit Waterpark Season Pass, the child day pass may be used for another elementary school friend.
